

7. MAYNE MAPS – APPLE ORCHARD MAPS

To map an apple orchard such as this, Alan uses many sources of data.

He extracts the relevant information from topographic maps as well as satellite images.

This is updated with any farm irrigation maps or other maps that the owner may have and then any spreadsheet information is included.

To complete the project, GPS data is often used. This data can be collected by the property owner or collected by Alan on-site.

If the property owner collects his own GPS data it can be emailed to Alan to reduce the cost of the map.

Alan uses Corel Draw to produce the maps.

Please zoom into these maps to view the fine detail that has been included at the request of the management.

When finished, the maps can be exported into any of 50 file types depending on the needs of the client and the purpose of the map.

Often, property owners ask Alan to produce a Location Map to help visitors locate the property. (See Location Map Tab)

As well as in the local area where Alan is based, he has also produced maps in South Australia, Tasmania and New Zealand without leaving Queensland.

Alan is now producing similar maps for properties outside of Australia.

A map such as this will often cost less than \$1000 depending on a number of factors.
